Giving Tree

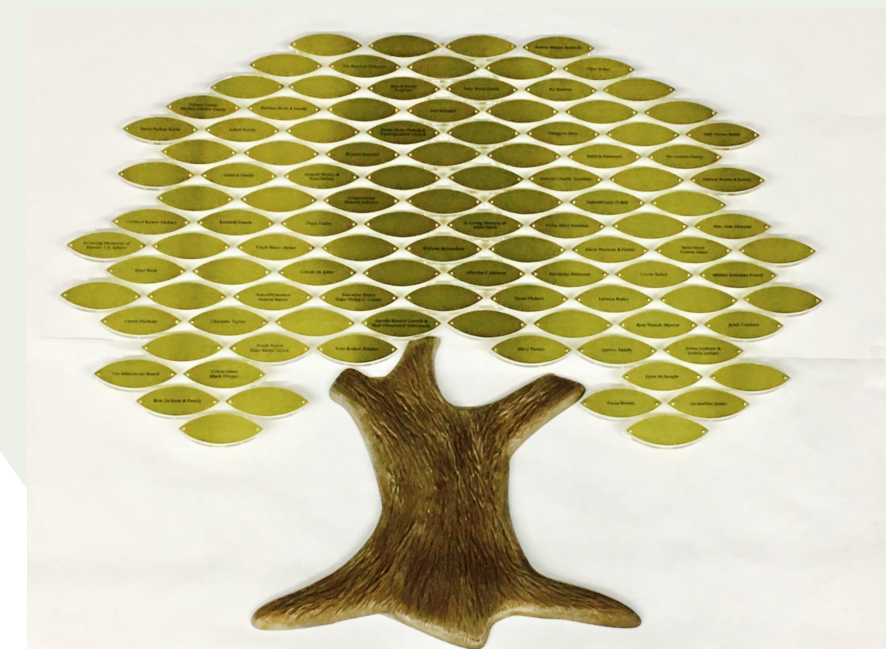
Purchase an engraved leaf to support the Seneca Falls Library

Leaves on the Giving Tree are now available for purchase. The Giving Tree is expected to be put on display beginning in September 2017.

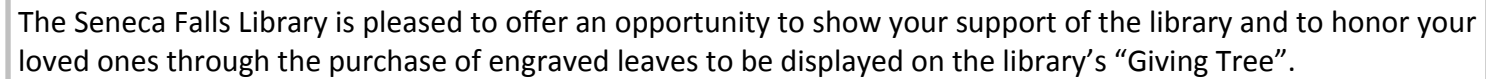
Monies raised through the sale of the engraved leaves will be used to purchase new books, equipment and materials, provide educational programming, and support facility operations and maintenance.

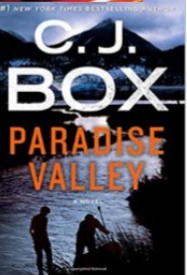
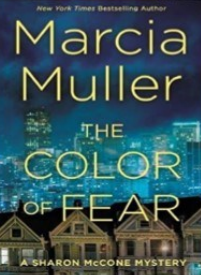
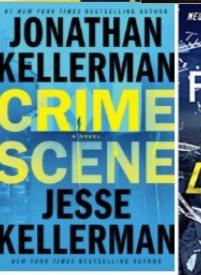
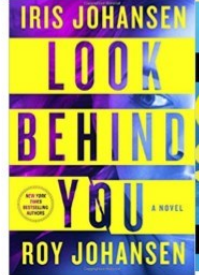
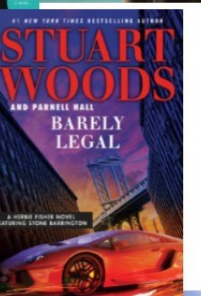
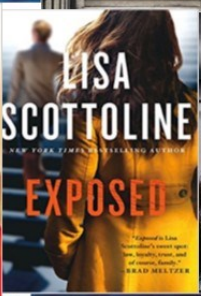
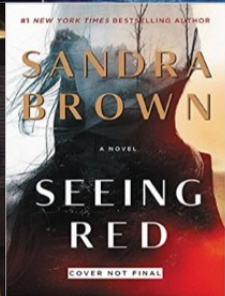
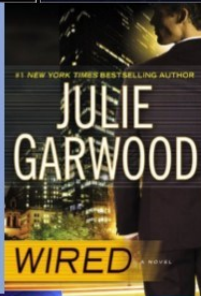
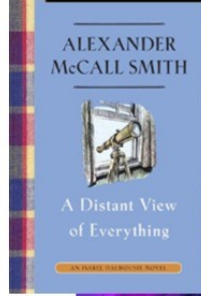
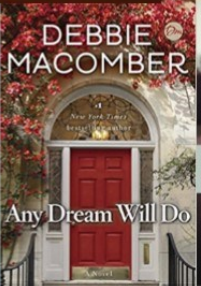
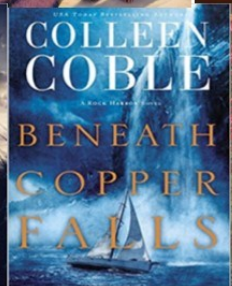
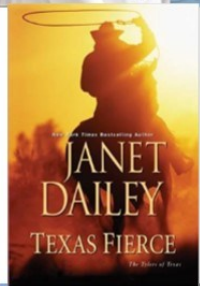
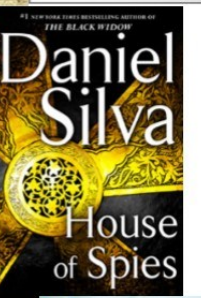
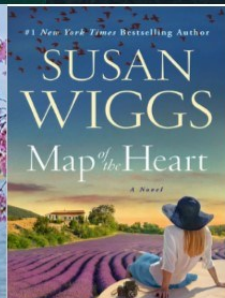
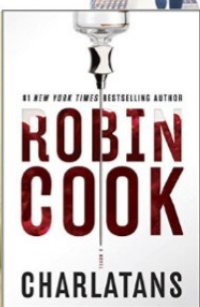
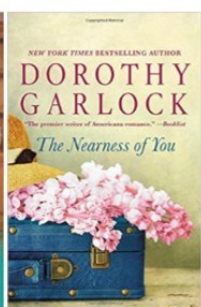
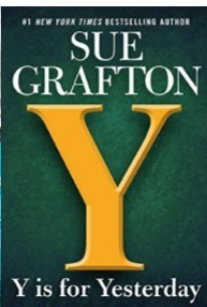
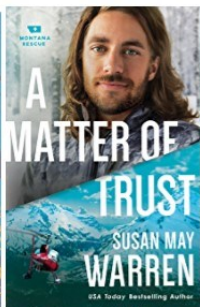
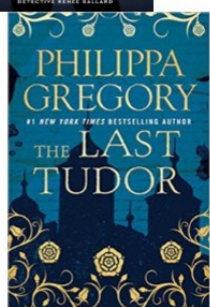
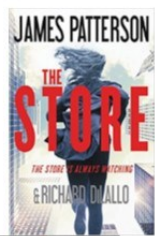


The Children's Book Festival was a fun event for all! Special thanks to the Friends of the Seneca Falls Library who donated gift baskets and helped to make this event possible!

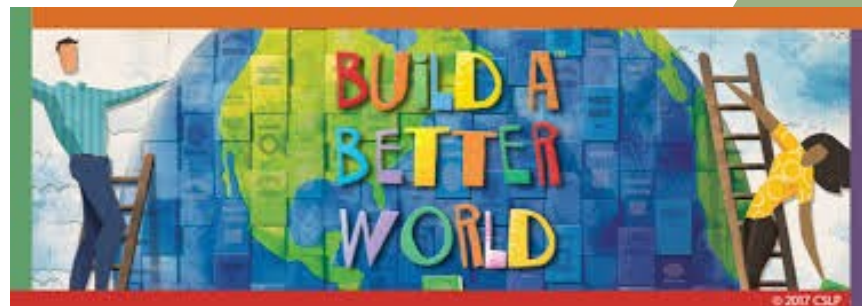

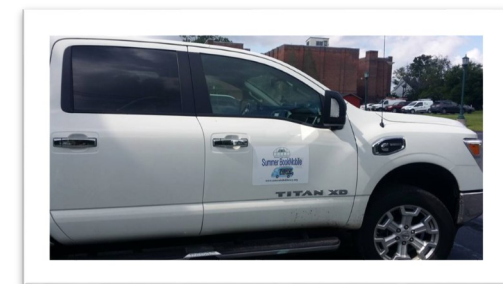
Bookmobile
