# THE HOUSE IS ALWAYS PACKED AT PRESCHOOL STORY TIMES

There are screams and giggles coming from the library! Thanks to a New York State Family Literacy Library Services Grant, the Seneca Falls Library has begun *Raising Readers*. From September 14th to December 15th, children's librarian Kathy Miller is bringing stories, music, finger play, and more to little ones and their caregivers throughout Seneca Falls and Waterloo. Mrs. Miller visits several Head Start and day care locations every week to read to local children and provide parents and caregivers with helpful tips on improving their children's mastery of the essential literacy skills necessary for young children to grow into successful readers.

In addition to reading to children around the community, Mrs. Miller hosts a story time each Wednesday at 10:00 am in the Josephine Littlejohn Meeting Room. Toddlers, preschoolers, their siblings, parents, and caregivers all come together to hear stories and develop a love of reading. Following Mrs. Miller's story time, it's time to sing and dance with Jill Fogel, a music teacher of over 30 years who specializes in using music to engage and encourage early readers.

There has been an amazing response to the story times in the library and around town; it's just more proof that the kids and families of Seneca Falls love to read!

This grant will allow the library to continue to provide *Raising Readers* story times through 2011.


