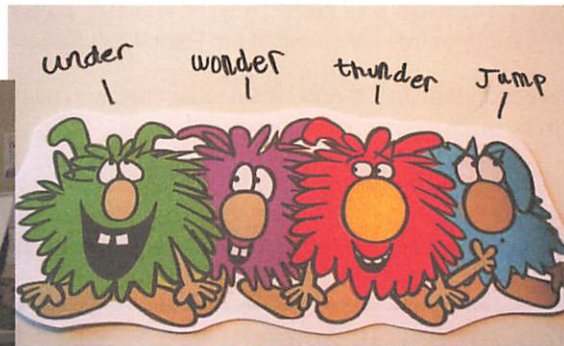

We receive about 60% of our budget from public sources (taxpayers living in the Seneca Falls School District, the Town of Seneca Falls and Seneca County), and that percentage has been steadily declining in recent years. The rest must be raised every year by the library. The most crucial avenue of support we have is our membership, the dedicated people who donate funds to the library. Being a cardholder doesn't make you a member, but donating to the library's Love the Library Membership Drive does!

Money donated to the library through the membership drive goes directly to our operating costs; it's used to buy books and other materials for the collection, and to help pay for programs for all ages.
