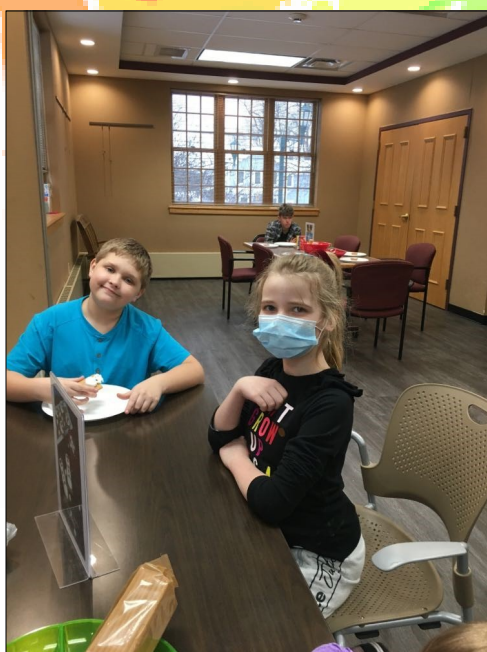

A complete job description and information on how to apply will be made available on the library website at www.senecafallslibrary.org/about-us/jobs-sfl beginning in early March.

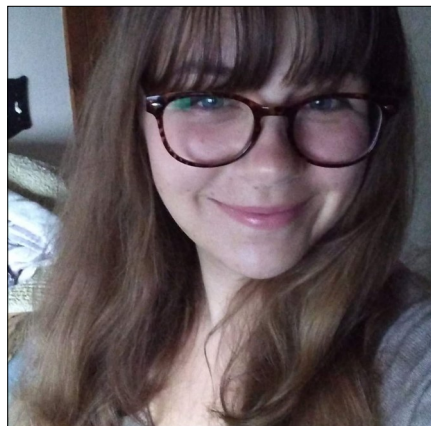

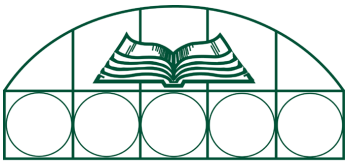
