Dear Fellow Patrons:

If you think libraries don't change to better meet the patrons' needs, you haven't visited the Seneca Falls Library recently.

For many years the library was a major resource for those seeking to use a computer and access the Internet. The center area of the library featured more than a dozen patron computers which at times were all in use.

Covid ended that. With all the libraries closed for three months, many of our regular computer users found other ways to connect, many purchasing their own computer or tablet. The result is that most of our computers were no longer getting any use.

With the leadership of Director Jenny Burnett, facilities were re-arranged; the number of computers was reduced and they were relocated. Now the center area of the library is open for programming.

The other major change during 2022 was the addition of Luke Lorenzetti to develop teen and adult programming, long a weak spot in our efforts. The change has been dramatic, as many more programs with good or excellent participation have taken place. You will see even more growth in this area in 2023.

All this while the services you have long expected from us continue.

Due to the overwhelming support of our community, we have been able to fulfill one of our long range plan goals earlier than expected. This year we hired our first Teen and Adult Services Coordinator, Luke Lorenzetti. Luke has been pivotal in creating a new range of programs and experiences for our teen and adult patrons. In his first year here, Luke has created more than 180 programs which have been attended by more than 1,400 patrons. We look forward to all the new and exciting services and

programming we can provide with this new position.




