Any University institution whose annual report for the preceding school year is not filed before the 20th day of September shall not participate in any apportionments unless such neglect is duly excused for sufficient reason. Any institution failing for two consecutive years to report shall be deemed to have discontinued its educational operations, and after due notice its charter may be suspended as provided in section 31 of the University law.
