Besides the installation of the console, the library has been growing its Switch collection for patrons who wish to borrow games.



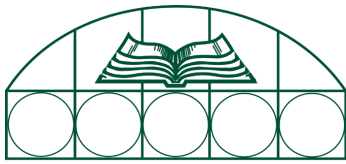
