Renovation Complete

The restroom renovation was completed on June 21st - just in time for the start of the Summer Reading Program! There are now three, individual restrooms available for public use. These provide more privacy than the former restrooms. One is large enough to allow access to patrons using motorized scooters.

A new book drop was also installed. This feature will allow better care of books that are being returned.

Wave Dancer

A fun addition was added this summer to the library lawn: an inflatable wave dancer!
